CITY COUNCIL MINUTES July 15, 2020

City Council of the City of Ephrata, Grant County Washington met in regular session on July 15, 2020. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Bruce Reim. Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic and Governor Inslee's Proclamation 20-28, this meeting is being conducted telephonically using the ZOOM audio only conferencing.

Members Present: Mayor Bruce Reim, Mayor Pro Tem William Coe, Council members Mark Wanke, Matt Moore, Valli Millard, Sarah McDonnell, and Tony Mora.

Staff Present: City Administrator Mike Warren, City Attorney Anna Franz, Public Works Director Bill Sangster, Interim Police Chief Erik Koch, Fire Chief Jeremy Burns and Administrative Assistant Carrie Lnenicka.

Motion to excuse Council member Allstot (m/s McDonnell/ second unidentifiable)
Motion carried.

Minutes of the July 1, 2020 Council meeting

Police Surplus of Carriers and Panels: The Police Department is requesting the surplus and subsequent destruction by incineration outdated and expired ballistic vests and carriers. These 5 vests could not be located during the initial surplus from February 2020 and have since been found. Council discussion ensued.

Motion to surplus expired ballistic vests. (m/s Wanke/McDonnell) Moore voted Nay, motion carried.

Agreement for Professional Services for Architectural Service with DOH & Associates: This contract will allow the city to enter into an agreement with DOH & Associates to begin the redesign of the roof of the Library. The design cannot exceed \$4600.

Motion to authorize administrative to enter into agreement for professional services for architectural services with DOH (m/s McDonnell/Moore). Council discussion ensued. Motion carried.

C Street Sidewalk Contract Approval: The bid for the C Street Sidewalk project came in at \$273,451.50 from Central Paving. Bid approval is subject to the approval of the bond per the city attorney.

Motion to accept C Street Contract Approval authorize administration to approve contract with Central Paving LLC (m/s Mora/Millard) Motion carried.

Well & Chlorination Report: Director Sangster reported that after 2 concurrent negative testings, Well 3 is now online and functioning property. Chlorination of all wells is pending the Health Department's finalization of the city's plans. The city is hoping to have this completed by the end of August.

It is that time of year again where I must ask you to declare September 2020 as Childhood Cancer Awareness Month. I'm asking 242 mayor's from all over WA state and Gov Inslee for this proclamation request. My first year (2018) I received over 100 proclamations back from many of you. In 2019 I got 153 back. This year I would love to beat that number.

My daughter, Layla, was diagnosed with Stage 4 High Risk Neuroblastoma on October 29, 2015. She was 18 months old. Layla finished treatment at Seattle Children's Hospital on February 21, 2017 and turned 3 years old on March 14, 2014. She has successfully completed treatment and is now in the Survivorship program at Fred Hutch. Layla is 6 years old now, her big brother, Owen is 9.

Ever since the end of our treatment I've been asking for more awareness from all over the state of this life-threatening disease.

WHEREAS, pediatric cancer is the leading cause of death by disease in children; and

WHEREAS, 1-in-285 children in the United States will be diagnosed by their 20th birthday; and

WHEREAS, 80 percent of childhood cancer cases are diagnosed only after the disease has metastasized and spread to other parts of the body; and

WHEREAS, two-thirds of childhood cancer patients will have long-lasting chronic conditions as a result of the treatment they go through; and

WHEREAS, there has been a twenty-four percent increase in pediatric cancer cases over the last forty years, equal to forty-three children per day or 15,780 children a year diagnosed with cancer in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the National Cancer Institute recognized the unique research needs of childhood cancer and increased funding to conduct this research; and

WHEREAS, researchers and healthcare professionals work diligently to dedicate their expertise to treat and cure children with cancer; and

WHEREAS, too many children are affected by this deadly disease and more must be done to raise awareness and find a cure for all childhood cancers;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Bruce Reim, Mayor of Ephrata, do hereby declare September, 2020 to be
