CLASSIFICATION ELEMENTS:

The position of Temporary Park employee is responsible for the maintenance and care of city owned park grounds and recreational areas. Work involves the skillful operation of a variety of hand and power tools and power equipment in the care of lawns, trees, plants, flowers, recreational facilities, or buildings on or near the location of park and recreational facilities. This position will be required to perform various skilled and unskilled tasks as assigned. The skill involved in performing the work will vary from one assignment to another. Employee may be assigned to a specific project or specialized area of responsibility at one park or recreational facility or at several parks or areas. Instructions are received in the form of oral or written directives or activity schedules as to the result desired with the employee expected to carry out tasks independently. The Park Foreman, Park Lead and/or Public Works Field Supervisor evaluate work performance through on-site inspections for the knowledge and skill required for said maintenance activities and for the timely completion of assignments.

ASSIGNMENTS INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:

1. Performs the full range of grounds maintenance tasks; mows, rakes, edges, sweeps, prunes, irrigates, fertilizes and trims lawns, trees, flowers, and shrubs.
2. Performs other work as assigned.

SPECIAL SKILLS, KNOWLEDGE, ABILITIES AND/OR CERTIFICATION

1. A valid driver's license with an acceptable driving record.
2. The ability to pass pre-employment and random drug screenings.
3. The ability to work weekends and holidays.
4. The ability to lift 75 pounds.
