Basic skill development will be taught in the morning and skill positions will be focused on in the afternoon. The afternoon will also include team and situation play. Hitting, running, catching, and throwing will be part of the instruction during all phases of the camp. Players will need to bring (where possible) their own baseball shoes, fielding gloves, and bats. All coaches at the camp will be a part of the Columbia Basin River Dogs program, as will the instructional team. This camp is open to both boys and girls and while the focus will be on baseball, many of the skills will enhance softball play as well. There will be some awards given to deserving campers at the end of the program.
